Who is Oakley Burks and Am I Related to Her?

Introduction

My name is Burks Oakley II and I was named after my father, Burks Oakley (1898-1969). In turn, my father's given name was his mother's maiden name – his mother was Kate Cameron Burks (1873-1954). We can trace Kate's **Burks** ancestral line in America back to John Burks (1655-1721), who was born in Ireland and immigrated to America, settling in Virginia. See:

Since my given name is Burks, I always am interested in finding new *Burks* family relatives. I have my DNA profile on the Ancestry.com website, and I have found many of my *Burks* relatives through DNA matches. I even found a cousin named Jackie Burks Oakley (her maiden name was *Burks*, and she married an *Oakley*):



Is it Possible that there is an Oakley Burks?


A week or so ago, I spoke with someone who said that he had a difficult time finding my e-mail address. I thought that was somewhat strange, since I am all over the web. So a few days ago, I Googled my name to see how difficult it would be to find my e-mail address.

The Google search turned up lots and lots of hits. The top three were:



I continued to look at the results of this Google search, which was really quite fortunate, because I found the following:










Is it Possible that I am Related to Oakley Burks?

I immediately wondered if Oakley Burks and I are related to each other. So I continued searching with Google. I played with the search terms, and eventually used "oakley burks oklahoma" (no quotes). One of the top ten hits was to an obituary for Jimmy Carl Burks:

Obituary for Jimmy Carl Burks

Jimmy Carl Burks, 70 was born June 29, 1950 in Yanush, OK to Herbert Franklin Burks and Hazel (Goodson) Burks. Jimmy passed from this life December 24, 2020 at Lindsey Municipal Hospital in Lindsey, Oklahoma. Jimmy graduated from Buffalo Valley High School in 1969. After graduation, he married Barbara Bagwell in October 1969. Together they had three children, Larry, Karla, and Jason, that he was always so proud of. In 1983 Jimmy married Nancy Johnson and gained two stepchildren that he loved dearly, Darrell and Angela McIntosh. Jimmy worked construction and operated heavy machinery, he worked for Latimer County Barn in Buffalo Valley, where he made many good friends. He was always known for getting in everyone's lunch boxes and helping himself to some lunch, mostly the sweets. Jimmy enjoyed hunting (and poaching a few deer), one of the many traits he passed on to his son Larry. He took Larry hunting on Buffalo Mountain on countless occasions, legally, and this is where Larry killed his first deer. Jimmy also loved to dance, he would two-step with Karla at the street dance when a street dance was an actual street dance. Jimmy loved to laugh and pull jokes on people. He bought Jason a go-cart and first time Jason drove it he went right under the truck, then bought him a bb-gun, which Jason shot Karla in the eye with through a window. Jason never got in trouble, dad would always say, "leave him alone he is just a baby

Jimmy leaves behind his three children: son Larry and wife Tayna Burks of Talihina, OK, daughter Karla and husband Kris Holland of Talihina, OK, and son Jason Carl Burks of McAlester, OK, stepdaughter, Angela and husband Brian Johnson of Talihina, OK, grandsons: Zachary Burks of Elmore City, OK, Colton VanHorn of McAlester, OK, Jayton and Jaxton Burks of McAlester, OK, Dalton McIntosh of Talihina, OK, Darrell Johnson of Talihina, OK, granddaughters: Haley Burks Jennings of Elmore City, OK, Oakley Burks of Talihina, OK, Dayton and Khloe Holland of Talihina, OK, Jaycee Burks of McAlester, OK, Chelsea Holland of AR, and Kailee Daney of Talihina, OK great grandchildren: Elena VanHorn, Bryson Lanning, Adalynn Holland, Laree and Bryson McIntosh.

Jimmy is preceded in death by his parents: Herbert Burks and Hazel Phillips, step father Harvey Phillips, brothers Gary Don Burks and Franklin Herbert Burks II, sister Linda Burks Watts and stepson Darrell McIntosh. Jimmy's laugh will always be remembered and never forgotten, he will always be in our hearts and looking after us from above.

Graveside Memorial Service will be on Friday, January 8th, 2020 at 2:00 PM at Cupco Cemetery in Yanush, Oklahoma with Bro. Kenny Bryant officiating. Cremation services are being provided by McCarn Funeral Service of Talihina, Oklahoma.

From this obituary, I learned that:

- One of his granddaughters was Oakley Burks of Talihina, Oklahoma.
- His son Larry Burks also lives in Talihina, Oklahoma.
- His father was Herbert Burks.

From this, my best guess is that Larry Burks is Oakley's father.

I went back to Oakley's Facebook page, and I found that she went to Talihina High School and currently lives in Talihina. A quick glance at Larry Burks' Facebook page confirmed that he is Oakley's father.

Here is a Google Map showing the location of Talihina, Oklahoma:



Talihina is located ~65 miles southwest of Ft. Smith, Arkansas. Its name originated from two Choctaw words, 'tully' and 'hena', meaning "iron road", a reference to the railroad around which the town was built. But I digress....


If I am related to Oakley Burks, then I certainly was related to her paternal grandfather, Jimmy Carl Burks. So I looked a little more into this man – here is his entry from the Findagrave.com website:


Jimmy Carl Burks is buried in Cupco Cemetery in Yanush, Oklahoma, less than ten miles west of Talihina.

Other *Burks* family members are also buried in this cemetery:



Jimmy Carl's obituary stated that Herbert Burks was his late father, so my guess is that this man was Herbert Franklin Burks (1917-1985). And then Herbert Franklin Burks Jr. (1941-2005) would be Herbert's son and Jimmy Carl's older brother.¹

From here, I reasoned that I could find the rest of Oakley's *Burks* line on Ancestry.com. Here is the profile for Herbert Franklin Burks from the family tree owned by *Philles_VanHorn*:



The information in this profile is completely consistent with all that I assumed up to this point. And this profile shows that Herbert Franklin Burks' father was Oscar H. Burks (1892-1960).

¹ As an aside, it appears that Nadine Burks (1940-2007) is <u>not</u> a close relative of the other **Burks** family members buried in this cemetery. I was able to trace her family tree back to John Burks (1655-1721), who I mentioned in the introductory paragraph.

Here is a profile for Oscar Herbert Burks (1892-1960) from a family tree owned by *gfbecker*:



This profile shows that Oscar Herbert's son was Herbert F. Burks, and that his father was David Burks (1858-1937).

Continuing back on the *Burks* line, here is the profile for David Burks from the family tree owned by *gfbecker*:



I'm covering a large number of generations here. I wonder if this *Burks* line will ever intersect with mine...

The profile for David Burks lists his father as James Edward Burks (1818-1891). Continuing back, here is a profile for James Edward Burks from the family tree owned by Brian Embree:




Well, this is encouraging, since James Edward Burks was born in Virginia, and my *Burks* ancestors originally lived in Virginia.

This profile shows that James Edward Burks' parents were James Burks (1774-1864) and his wife Elizabeth "Betsy" Townsend (1780-1845).

I next looked at James Burks in the family tree owned by Brian Embree. Could it be that I'll finally connect back to my *Burks* line?




Oh my! This profile shows that James Burks' parents were William Burks (1750-1830) and Eliza Burks (I believe that her maiden name was *Cade*). This couple were my third-great grandparents.

Bingo! Oakley Burks is indeed my distant cousin!!

After my initial excitement wore off, I began to have second thoughts about this. The entry for William Burks in my family tree on Ancestry.com doesn't have a son named James Burks (1774-1864). I do have an Allen James Burks (1771-1864) who was married to Elizabeth "Betsy" Townsend (1780-1850).

Here is my profile for Allen James Burks:



In comparing James Burks and Allen James Burks, some of the children are the same, and his wife Elizabeth Townsend is the same, and his place of birth is the same – but the birth year and the place of death are different. Of course, so is his name – Allen James Burks vs. James Burks.

This is so frustrating! On Ancestry.com, everyone has their own version of a family tree. And users copy lots of profiles into their own trees without doing any verification. So which of these profiles is correct?


I searched all the family trees on Ancestry.com for James Burks, who was born in 1774 in Virginia, who died in 1864 in North Carolina, who was the son of William Burks and a woman whose last name was Cade. Here are the results of that search:



The search turned up Allen James Burks – and he appears in 1015 family trees on Ancestry.com. But this search did NOT turn up a James Burks (this search didn't get the entry for James Burks from Brian Embree's family tree, since he listed Elizabeth "Eliza" Cade by her married name, Eliza Burks.

The first hit from the search shown above was from the family tree named Burks123, which is owned by Russell Burks. This profile is based on 11 records and 96 sources, and it is in a tree with 8471 people. It seems that Russell Burks is a serious genealogist; he is descended from William Burks and his wife Elizabeth (Eliza) Cade through their son Allen James Burks Sr. (1771-1864).

At any rate, let's see what Russell Burks has for the profile of Allen James Burks, Sr. (who was his direct ancestor):




Well, this profile has Allen James Burks Sr.'s parents as William Burks and his wife Elizabeth (Eliza) Cade. It shows that Allen James Burks had 18 children, although William F. Burks appears twice. But most importantly, it has one of the children being James N. Burks (1818-1891), and this person is most likely a direct ancestor of Oakley Burks. In other trees, James appears as James Edward Burks, and even James N. Edward Burks. So Russell Burks' family tree seems to support the idea that Oakley Burks' line does go back to William Burks and his wife Eliza Cade.

At this point, I'm going to stop looking into this branch of the *Burks* family tree. There seems to be a lot of contradictory information in the many family trees, and I'm not sure that I could find the "truth".

Given the information that I have presented above, I'm 95% sure that Oakley Burks is a direct descendant of William Burks and his wife Elizabeth "Eliza" Cade.

Here is a chart showing how Oakley and I are most likely related:



Based on this chart, I was a fourth-cousin of Herbert Franklin Burks, which means that Oakley and I are fourth-cousins three-times removed.

One Last Question

In my extended family, my first-cousin David R. Oakley's youngest child was Catherine Anne Oakley (born in 1967). Cathy married Gary Bunce, and they named their first son Oakley Robert Bunce (born in 1996). As far as I know, that is the only example in my extended family of someone having the first name of Oakley.

My one remaining question is: How did Oakley Burks get the name Oakley?
