

Tracey Ford Moore – Part II

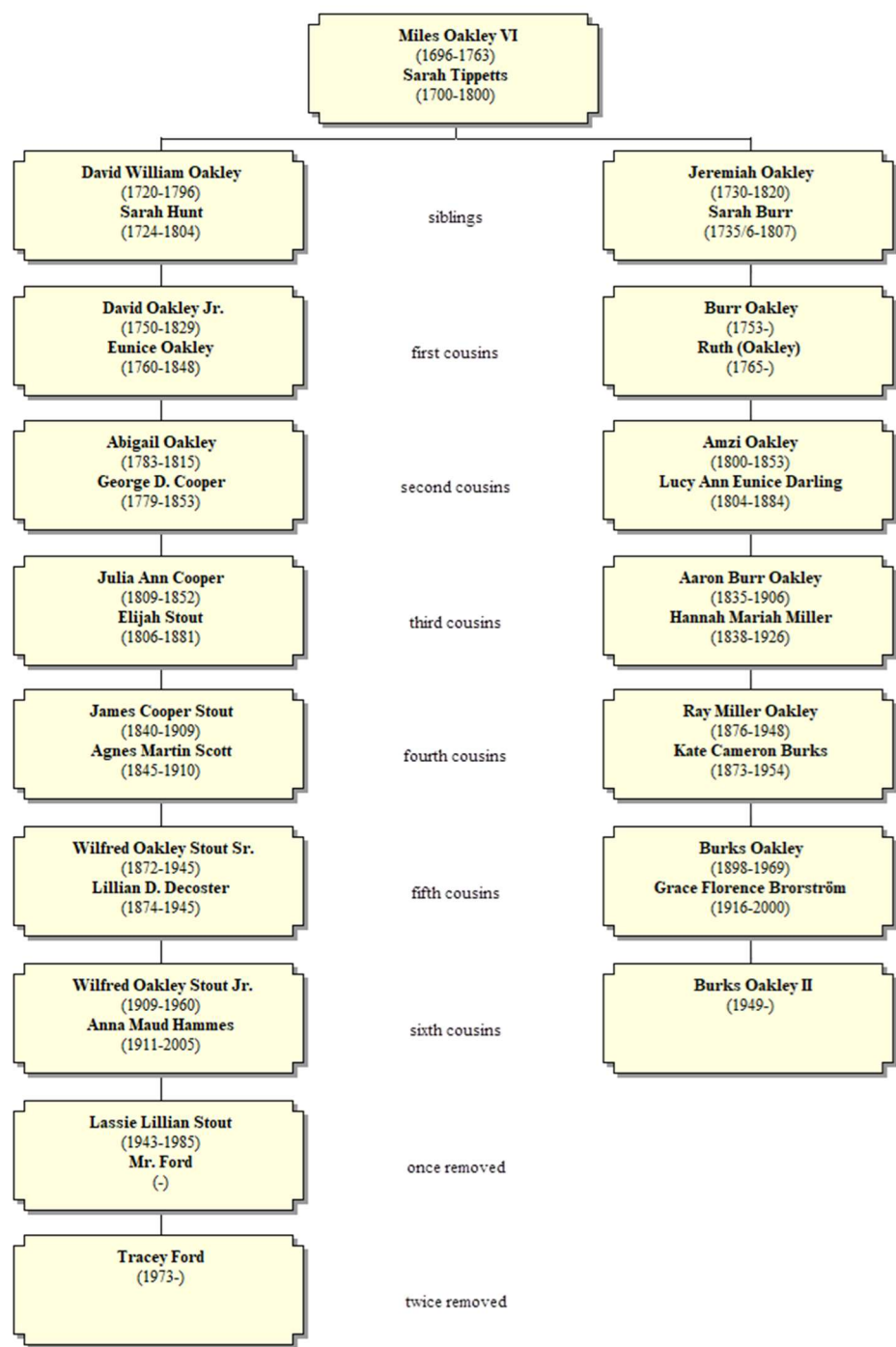
This past January, I wrote about my DNA match on Ancestry.com with Tracy Ford Moore. See:

Tracey and I have a 22 cM DNA match.

Over the past few months, I found more material that should have been included in that earlier document. And that is what this short narrative is about.

Let me begin with a chart showing how Tracey and I are related:



Tracey and I both are descended from Miles Oakley VI (1696-1763) and his wife Sarah Tippetts (1700-1800). Based on the relationship chart on the previous page, Tracey and I are sixth-cousins twice-removed. I was a sixth-cousin of her maternal grandfather, Wilfred Oakley Stout Jr. (1909-1960).

But the relationship chart on the previous page is not entirely accurate. In the upper-left corner of the chart, the line from Abigail Oakley (1783-1815) back to the ***Oakley-Tippetts*** couple goes through her father David Oakley Jr. and then his father, David William Oakley (1720-1796). This is correct, but it is incomplete.

I neglected to show that David Oakley Jr. and his wife Eunice Oakley (1760-1848) were “double first-cousins”.

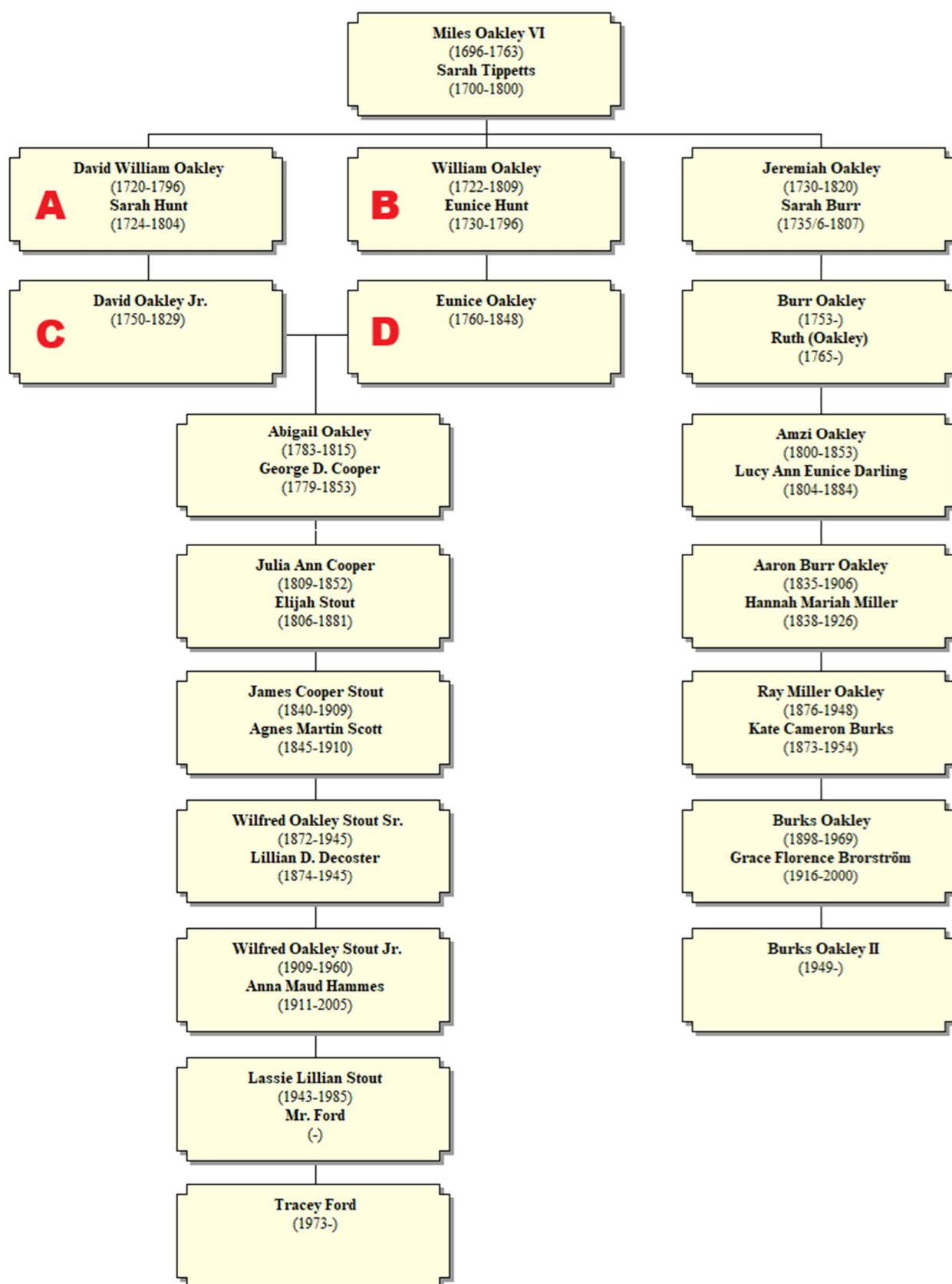
Two brothers, David William Oakley (1720-1796) and William Oakley (1722-1809), married two sisters, Sarah Hunt (1724-1804) and Eunice Hunt (1730-1796). The children of these two couples, David Oakley Jr. and Eunice Oakley, married each other. (!!)

This means that there was a line from Abigail Oakley back to the ***Oakley-Tippetts*** couple going through her mother (in addition to the line going back through her father).

I modified the relationship chart to account for the double first-cousins:



In the upper-left of this revised chart, the couples marked with the red A and red B are the two ***Oakley*** brothers who married the two ***Hunt*** sisters. David Oakley Jr., marked with the red C, was a son of couple A. Eunice Oakley, marked with the red D, was a daughter of couple B. David and Eunice, who were “double first-cousins”, married. One of their daughters was Abigail Oakley, who was Tracey Ford Moore’s fourth-great grandmother.

Now let me change gears. Tracey’s maternal grandfather was Wilfred Oakley Stout Jr. (1909-1960). When I Googled him, I found that he was on the faculty at the University of Chattanooga:

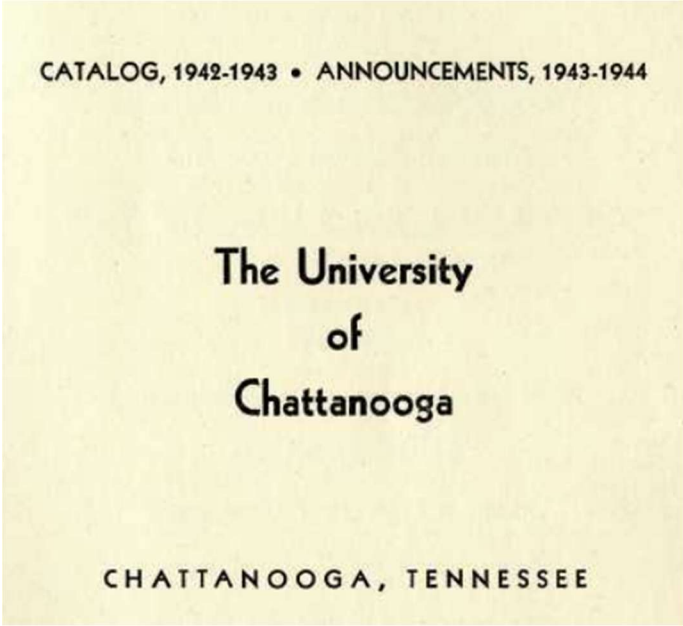

OMG! He has to be descended from Wilfred Oakley Stout Jr. – doesn't he?

I followed the male line (Richard Stout), hoping to get to the Wilfred Oakley Stout who is still living.

5732. Richard STOUT (Still Living.) Richard married Janet PALMER .

Children from this marriage were:

5940 F i. Louise STOUT (Still Living.)

5941 F ii. Alice STOUT (Still Living.)

5942 F iii. Sarah STOUT (Still Living.)

5943 M iv. **Wilfred Oakley STOUT (Still Living.)**

OMG! That's him! And Wilfred Oakley Stout (still living) is the son of Richard Stout, and Richard's sister was Lassie Stout, who was Tracey Ford Moore's mother. That means that Wilfred Oakley Stout (still living) is Tracey's first-cousin. And there is a really good chance that he has the **Oakley-Browne** DNA segment on Chromosome 15.

How cool is this? Wilfred Oakley Stout (still living) is another **Oakley** relative to add to my family tree. And the last ancestor he had with the **Oakley** surname was Abigail Oakley (1783-1815). I wonder if he knows any of this...

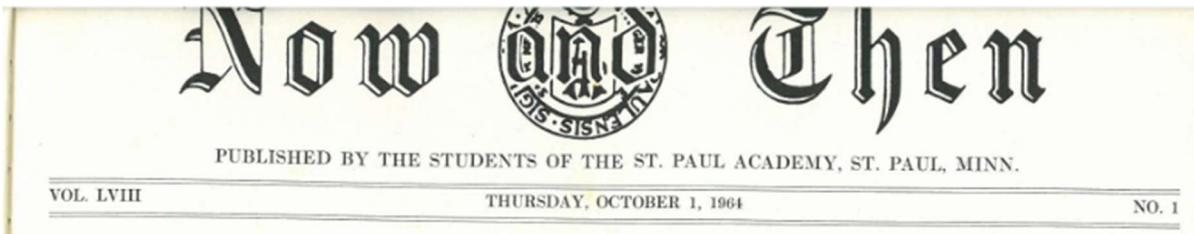

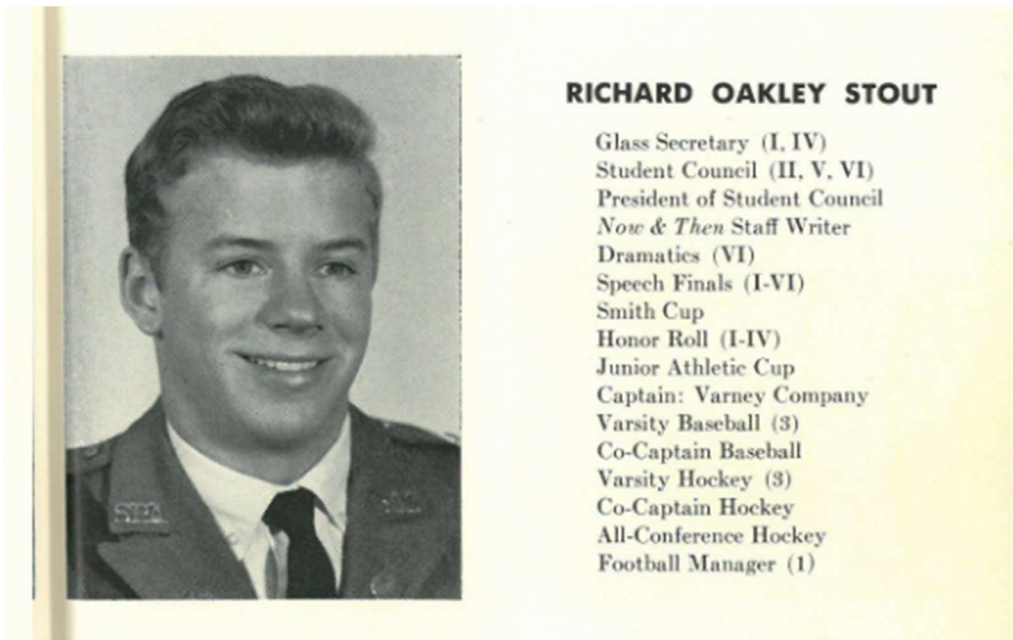

OMG yet again! Wilfred’s father’s middle name also is Oakley – Richard Oakley Stout! Amazing that they still are using the **Oakley** name. And when I Googled Richard, I found a copy of the *Now and Then* newspaper published by the students of the St. Paul Academy in St. Paul, Minnesota, on October 1, 1964:



This issue of the newspaper included the following for cousin¹ Richard:



Wow! A very impressive high school career, don’t you think?

I then Googled “Richard Oakley Stout” and I found:

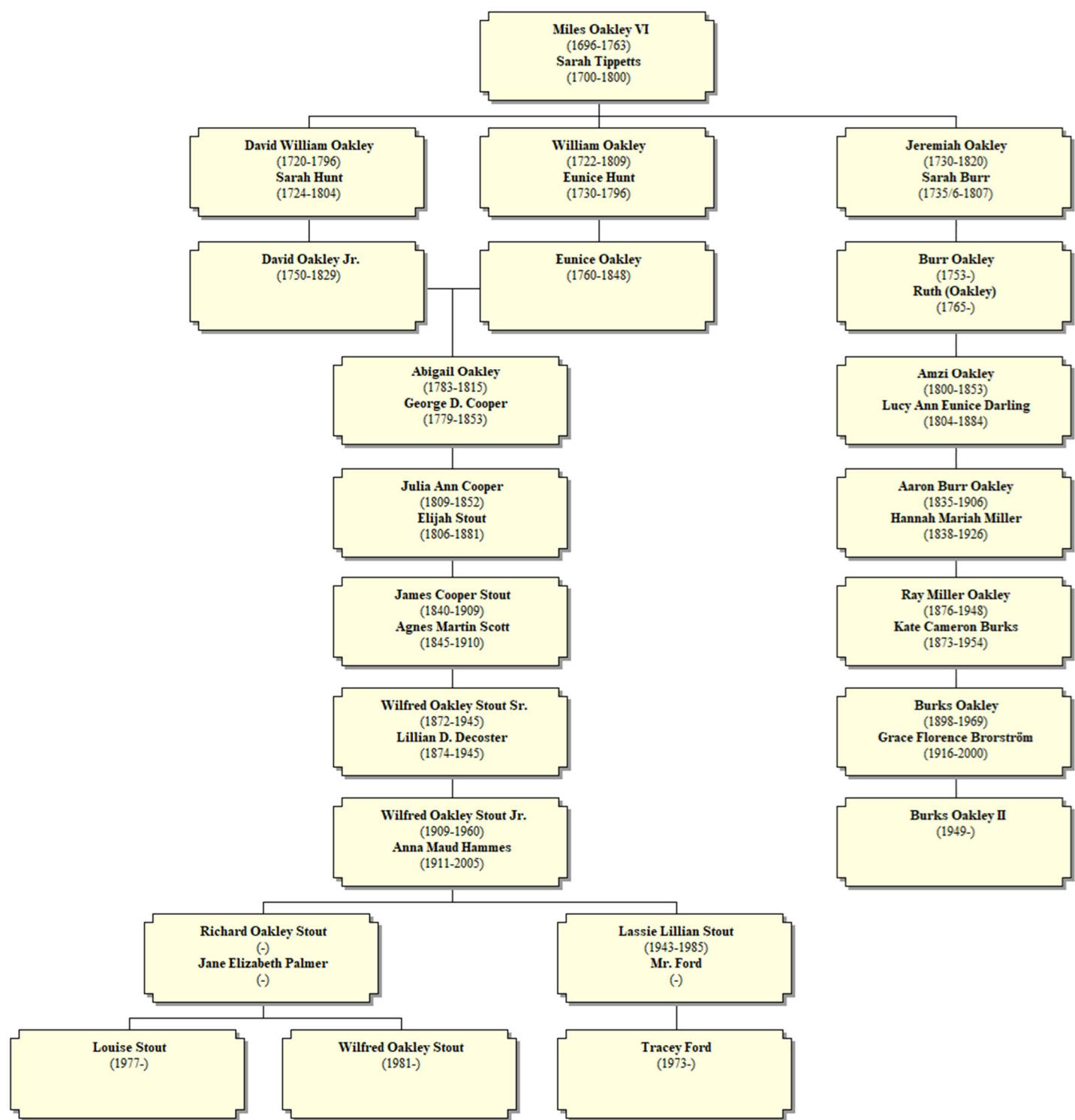

It would appear that Louise is the older sister of Wilfred Oakley Stout (still living).

¹ He is my sixth-cousin once-removed, just like Tracey’s mother Lassie.

I added Richard Oakley Stout, his wife Janet Elizabeth Palmer, his daughter Louise Stout, and his son Wilfred Oakley Stout (still living) to my RootsMagic database. Here is a chart showing how we all are related:



The lower-left corner of this updated chart has new descendants of Wilfred Oakley Stout Jr. (1909-1960) – Richard Oakley Stout and his children Louise Stout (1977-) and Wilfred Oakley Stout (1981-).

Summary: In this narrative, I first went back and showed the complete ancestral line from Tracey Ford Moore back to the **Oakley-Tippetts** couple. I edited our relationship chart to account for the “double first-cousins” in Tracey’s line.

I also included some new material about Tracey’s maternal grandfather, Wilfred Oakley Stout Jr. (1909-1960). This man (my sixth-cousin) had A.B. and M.A. degrees from Princeton University, and he was a professor at the University of Chattanooga.

Finally, I learned through Google searches that there is yet another person named Wilfred Oakley Stout. This man is the son of Richard Oakley Stout, who is Tracey Ford Moore's uncle. Wilfred Oakley Stout (still living) works in the medical profession in east-central Minnesota. I also found Richard Oakley Stout's daughter, Louise.
